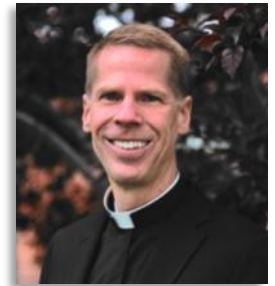

## Pastor's Blog



### Every Saint Has a Past

The woman had been caught in the very act of adultery – and the scribes and Pharisees were delighted! This was their chance to spring the perfect trap on Jesus. They paraded her in front of the crowd, not thinking once about her shame and embarrassment. “Moses commanded us to stone this woman – what do you say?” They had Jesus right where they wanted. If he consented to the stoning, they would report him to the authorities for violating Roman law. If Jesus forbade the stoning, he would violate the law of Moses and be a false Messiah. But, in his divine wisdom, Jesus turned the tables on her accusers and caught them in their own trap. “Let him who is without sin among you be the first to throw a stone at her.”

We don't know her name. We don't know the circumstances of her life which led her to that moment. All we know is that she was a precious daughter of God who deserved justice but received mercy. Her accusers dropped their stones and walked away in their own shame and embarrassment. She was alone with the Son of God. “Has no one condemned you? Neither do I. Go and sin no more.” He didn't condone her sin. He forgave her past and offered her a new future. She would not have to pay the price for her sin. He would pay it for her, later, on a cross.

### Why do we cover the sacred images in the church during Lent?

The tradition is to cover crosses and images on the Fifth Sunday of Lent. Neither the Stations of the Cross nor stained glass windows are veiled. As the church approaches Easter, our Mass readings begin to focus more intensely on the Passion, Death and Resurrection of Jesus Christ. Families are also encouraged to imitate this practice and veil prominent religious images in their homes. It helps us to participate in the liturgical season. The unveiling before the Easter Vigil is a great reminder of our own life on earth. We live in a "veiled" world, in exile from our true home. Even our eyes get to "fast" from the beautiful art in the church during the Lenten Season.


