


Quarterly Rosary Walk

It would not be enough to proclaim an empty tomb. For

his followers to be willing to die for their faith, they had to encounter the risen Lord, himself.

This weekend, we find ourselves back in Galilee with Peter and six of the Apostles. Peter resorts to what he always does when he needs to clear his head – he goes fishing. The seven friends fish all night but catch nothing. (Sound familiar?) At first, they do not recognize their glorified Lord standing on the shore calling out to them, "Catch anything? Try casting over the right side of the boat." But when the net starts to strain with fish, they recognize their beloved master. Peter dives in and swims the hundred yards to shore. Waiting for him on the beach, Jesus has breakfast ready – fish cooking over a charcoal fire. Peter winces as the sight of the fire transports him back to the night when he denied his master while warming himself over a charcoal fire. Jesus repeats his question three times – once for each denial. "Do you love me?" The third time Peter, looking down, says in a quiet voice, "Lord, you know everything; you know that I love you."

Peter, the first shepherd of the Church, speaks for us. "Lord, you know I love you in spite of my failings, my weakness, my brokenness, my sinfulness." And Jesus smiles and says to Peter and to us, "Follow me."

Family of the Month March 2025 Stanton G. & Maria LaBreche




This family has served not only the Knights of




