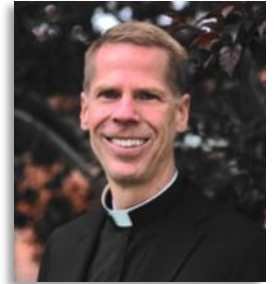

Pastor's Blog

Habemus Papam!



Last Sunday, the risen Jesus had an intimate conversation with Peter on the shore of the Sea of Galilee. Three times he asked Peter, "Do you love me?" Three times, Peter responded, "Yes Lord, you know that I love you." Then Jesus gave him a new command: "Tend my sheep." Three years earlier, along that same shoreline, Jesus first called Peter, "Come follow me and I will make you a fisher of men." Now Peter was given a new mission. His role in the Kingdom was changed from fisherman to shepherd. Jesus, the Good Shepherd, was entrusting the care of his sheep to Peter.

Two thousand years later, the Church welcomes her next shepherd – Cardinal Robert Francis Prevost of Chicago, who has chosen the name Pope Leo XIV. The conclave, whose task was to listen to the Holy Spirit and discern God's will for the next shepherd of the Church began on Wednesday. The eyes of the world were on Rome – specifically the chimney above the Sistine Chapel which, on Thursday evening with white smoke, signaled the news. A little over an hour later, the announcement was made from the balcony of St. Peter's Basilica: "I announce to you a great joy: We have a pope!"

The time of mourning for Pope Francis has been completed. The 267th successor of Peter has been chosen. The words of the prophet Jeremiah are fulfilled: "I will turn their mourning into joy". Praise God! We have a Pope!

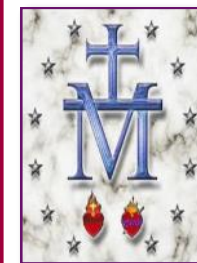





Sacraments
