



The Path to Holiness

The path to holiness involves conversion of the heart, the enlightenment of the mind, and union with God which leads to the gift of self.

This weekend, we approach the end of our three-month meditation on the suffering, death and resurrection of Christ. We begin to look forward to the coming of the Holy Spirit. Our readings lead us to contemplate the path to holiness.

St. Paul encourages the Christians in Antioch, "It is necessary for us to undergo many hardships to enter the kingdom of God." While Paul is referring to the persecution they suffered for belonging to Christ, he is also talking about the path to holiness. The reading mentions prayer and fasting – a crucial element of the spiritual life. Conversion of heart is painful. It involves a humbling realization of personal sin and death to self. During Lent, we experienced once again conversion of heart.

John in the Book of Revelation, enlightens our minds with the vision of union with God. "God will dwell with his people." We look forward with hope to this union in heaven and at the end of time, but the spiritual masters teach us that union with God is also possible in this life.

Jesus sums it all up with a new command: "Love one another as I have loved you." Self-gift is the fruit of God's indwelling presence in our souls. Come Holy Spirit, dwell within us, transform our hearts that we might love.






Sacraments


