



The Holy Spirit in Action

As Jesus was saying goodbye to the Apostles, he made them a



This weekend we see how the Holy Spirit steered the early church through uncharted territory. The question from the church at Antioch was, "What to do with Gentiles who want to become Christians?" Specifically, do they need to follow the Law of Moses and become Jewish first i.e. get circumcised? A delegation was sent to the Apostles in Jerusalem to settle the matter. At the Church's first council, Peter stood up and, having been given an earlier revelation from the Holy Spirit, spoke with authority — circumcision will not be necessary for a Gentile to become Christian. Just like the Pope and the Bishops do today, they sent a pastoral letter to the church at Antioch: "It is the decision of the Holy Spirit and of us..."

The Church is now over 2000 years old, and the Holy Spirit has guided her through waters both rough and smooth. This century, as in every century since Pentecost, the Church will face unique challenges. Thanks to Jesus' promise and the Holy Spirit's guidance and protection, the gates of hell shall not prevail against her. And that is the cause of our peace, hope and joy.

Community Center Lower Level Kitchen Project


We are excited to replace some of the items that are around 50 years old.




