






## St. Jude Father's Day Novena

## astor's Blog

#### The Breath of God



Pentecost marks the end of the Easter season and the fulfillment of Jesus' promise to his Apostles. We join Mary and the Apostles as the Holy Spirit descends upon them like the rush of a mighty wind and tongues of fire. The scene evokes the Hebrew image of *ruah* – the breath of God hovering over the waters at creation. We remember the burning bush as God revealed himself to Moses. We recall the pillar of fire that led the Israelites through the desert.

The Holy Spirit is about power – the power to be transformed from sinner into saint. Before Pentecost, Peter denied Christ three times. After Pentecost, he welcomed crucifixion. Before Pentecost, the Apostles ran away into the night. After Pentecost, they spread the Gospel to the ends of the earth and all but one died as martyrs. The Holy Spirit makes it possible for us to be Christian.

Today we pray with St. Augustine:

Breathe in me, O Holy Spirit, that my thoughts may all be holy. Act in me, O Holy Spirit, that my work, too, may be holy. Draw my heart, O Holy Spirit, that I love but what is holy. Strengthen me, O Holy Spirit, to defend all that is holy. Guard me, then, O Holy Spirit, that I always may be holy. Amen.


