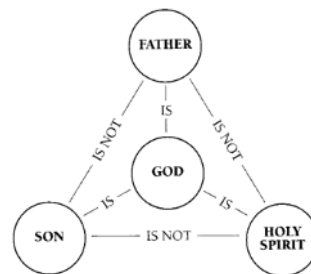

Trinity Sunday: A Family Affair

For centuries, the central core of Israel's belief was recited twice daily in a prayer called the Shema. "Hear O Israel, the Lord your God is one..." The surrounding nations worshipped many gods. Israel worshipped one – Yahweh, the Lord of Hosts.

Jesus got into hot water with the Jewish leaders because he called himself the Son of God. At Pentecost, a third Person was revealed – the Holy Spirit. The God who Israel worshipped as one, was three.



It took the Church centuries of contemplation to begin to understand this mystery that God could be one – yet three. The language she developed was "Three persons in one God".

Pope St. John Paul II shed more light on the beauty of the mystery when he taught that the inner life of God is a communion of persons – a family – giving and receiving love. You and I are made in the image of God. We are made for the sole purpose of giving and receiving love.

We begin every prayer in the name of the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. After two thousand years, those words just roll off the tongue and we tend to take the mystery for granted. Once a year, on Trinity Sunday, we pause and contemplate the nature of God "from whom every family in heaven and on earth gets its name". (Eph 3:15) How's your family doing?

Sacraments

Baptisms: A pre-baptismal session is required for parents and godparents. Please call the office at 303-988-6435 before or after the child's birth, before you choose godparents, to register. **The next class is July 26th from 9am-12pm** in the Community Center lower level.

Marriage: Those who wish to be married at St. Jude Church must be registered in the parish for at least one year. Sons and daughters of registered parishioners may also be married here. A 10-month preparation period is required. Please call the office at 303-988-6435 and talk to Sharon Hensley.
