

Sacred Heart of Jesus Novena

The Sacred Heart Novena will be prayed during the nine days leading up to the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, which is always 19 days after Pentecost on a Friday. In

2025, the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus falls on June 27th.

In 2025, the Sacred Heart Novena began on June 18th and end on June 26th. We will be praying the novena here at St. Jude after the 8am daily Mass, in front of the statue of the Sacred Heart of Jesus over the weekend after the 5pm Mass on Saturday and after the 11am Mass on Sunday. You are welcome to join us in consecrating our parish to the Sacred Heart.

Who the heck was Melchizedek?

Although we are technically back in Ordinary Time, this weekend we linger just a bit longer unpacking the mysteries of Easter. Last Sunday we meditated upon The Holy Trinity. Today, we contemplate the Real Presence of Our Lord in the Eucharist. Jesus ascended to the Father, but he remains with us in the Eucharist.

This weekend we encounter the mysterious figure of Melchizedek – an ancient priest king. Abram had just won a war against several kings who had captured his nephew, Lot, in battle. To help Abram give thanks to God for his victory, Melchizedek makes a thank-offering of bread and wine.


The Jews over time would develop many types of animal sacrifices – for guilt, for sin and the like. But they had a special sacrifice, offering bread and wine, called the *todah* – the thank-offering. The ancient rabbis used to say, "When the Messiah comes, all sacrifices will cease except one – the *todah*."

Fast forward to the last supper. Jesus is blessing bread and wine and declaring "This is my body...this is my blood." He is making a thank-offering. The church continues this offering throughout time. The Greek word for thanksgiving is *Eucharist*. At special masses, in Eucharistic Prayer I, Melchizedek's name is still recalled.

What makes Catholicism unique from all other religions is the real presence of Jesus on our altars, in our tabernacles and in our very bodies. Now that is a gift to be thankful for.




