Peace of Soul

There is nothing more peaceful than a baby at its mother's breast, drifting in



and out of sleep resting in its mother's arms. The second part of the book of Isaiah is called the book of consolation. Israel has suffered the consequences of her sin and now the Lord comforts her. The prophet gives us a beautiful image of God's love:

As nurslings, you shall be carried in her arms, and fondled in her lap; as a mother comforts her child, so will I comfort you.

The result of our relationship with God is peace of soul. This is the deep abiding peace that comes from complete trust in God and surrender to his love. This is the peace that comes from deep prayer – from letting the Word of God penetrate our soul. The Gospel acclamation this weekend invites us, "Let the peace of Christ control your hearts; let the word of Christ dwell in you richly."

When Jesus sent out the seventy-two, he instructed them, "Into whatever house you enter, first say, 'Peace to this household.' If a peaceful person lives there, your peace will rest on him."

Sometimes it feels like the world has been turned upside down – like the rug has been pulled out from under our feet. In these moments, we turn to God and rest, cradled in his arms.

I have stilled my soul. Like a weaned child on its mother's lap, so is my soul within me.


