

Hail Holy Queen

King Solomon had a dilemma. With 700 wives and 300 concubines, who would sit on the queen's



throne? The problem was resolved by honoring not the wife but the mother of the King. So, Solomon sat on his throne with the Queen Mother, Bathsheba, seated at his right. The people would come to the queen with their needs, and she would present them to her son. When the Queen would ask her son for a favor, he would say to her, "Ask, my mother, for I will not refuse you." (1Kings 2:19-20)

These past two weeks, the church has contemplated the fourth and fifth Glorious Mysteries of the Rosary. A week ago, we celebrated the Solemnity of Mary's Assumption into heaven. Seven days later, we celebrated her Queenship. What was prefigured in the Old Testament in the time of Solomon, is realized in the New Testament for us. We have a Queen Mother in heaven who looks out for us and sits at the right hand of her son's throne and presents our needs to him.

Just like at the wedding of Cana, she recognizes our needs and presents them to her son. And Jesus cannot refuse the request of his mother. Catholics do not worship the Blessed Mother. Like any family, she watches over her children, protects us, and always points us to her son.

Hail, Holy Queen...after this our exile show unto us the blessed fruit of thy womb, Jesus.

St Jude Special Education Program

Special Ed is designed to help the Developmentally Disabled learn about Jesus. We work with the students to prepare them to receive the Sacraments and learn how to live as a Christian in today's world. The class is designed to meet the needs of each student individually. We try to keep a 1:1 or 1:2 teacher/student ratio. Material for each student is selected on their learning needs and at their level of understanding. Students that have received all their Sacraments go over the Sunday Gospels (they read the gospel for the upcoming Sunday). Others choose to study the saints, the Rosary, Mary, etc. We start with large group where we each (student/teachers) share who they would like to pray for. Then we say the Our Father, Hail Mary and the Glory Be, and we break up into individual class or small groups to go over the day's lesson.

We meet on Tuesday nights from 6:30pm to 7:30pm, in the lower level of the Community Center. **The first class** is **September 2nd**. For more information please contact Diane Schreiber 303-980-5504


Calling all Youth Who have Made their First Communion!
