Two New Saints! Part One – St. Carlo Acutis



This weekend, Pope Leo XIV will canonize Blesseds Carlo Acutis and Pier Giorgio Frassati.

Carlo Acutis will be the first millennial saint. He was born in 1991 and raised in Milan. From a young age, Carlo had a special love for God. He loved to pray the rosary, and, after his first Communion, he went to Mass as often as possible.

He was known for standing up for kids at school who got bullied, especially kids with disabilities. He had a love for the poor and would bring food to people living on the streets.

Carlo had a passionate devotion to the Real Presence. He was a self-taught computer programmer and built a website on Eucharistic Miracles. He deeply believed that the scientific evidence from Eucharistic miracles would help convince people that Jesus is truly present in the Eucharist and they would return to Mass.

Carlo loved playing video games. He had conversations with his gaming buddies about the importance of going to Mass and confession and limited his video game playing to no more than two hours per week.

Carlo was diagnosed with leukemia as a teenager. He offered his sufferings for Pope Benedict XVI and for the Church. He died on Oct. 12, 2006, at the age of 15. His body, dressed in jeans and Nike tennis shoes, lies in repose in a glass tomb in Assisi. A teenage saint – imagine that.

During the past few months, we have been busy revamping, renewing, and renaming the 9 am choir here at St. Jude. After much thought, consideration, and prayer, the small group has decided on the name "Deo Cantus," which means "singing for God" or "a song to God." In Latin, "cantus," meaning song or chant, was also an occupational surname for singers or cantors. In essence, as Roman Catholic Christians, we are all called to be the voice of God to our communities and to the world. When Vatican II called for "full, active, and conscious" participation of our congregations, it launched the Church into unknown waters and theological conversations about the council's documents and their impact on our liturgical worship. We could no longer be passive in our liturgical postures or voices. Thus, Deo Cantus is an arm, a hand, and a voice of our community at St. Jude. As the Body of Christ, we invite you to join us in creating beautiful, prayerful, and joyful praise to God through your participation in the songs at Mass. Furthermore, we invite you to consider whether God might be calling you to become even more active in song by joining the choir. We would love to welcome new members to the group! 
