



### **Response to Evil**

The old-timers in Arizona would tell stories of sleeping outside in the summer. The heat of the house (before air conditioning) made it uncomfortable to sleep in a bedroom, so they moved beds into the backyards. The coolness of the dry desert air was welcomed... the ants however were not! Ants could climb up the bedposts, so a solution was created: kerosene. ### Signature Collection Drives at St. Jude Parish

The Colorado Catholic Conference of bishops support and encourage signature collection for Colorado initiatives #108 Penalties for Human Trafficking of a Minor, #109 Male and Female Participation in School Sports, and #110 Prohibit Certain Surgeries on Minors. These initiatives each require nearly 125,000 valid signatures within six months of their kick-off in early September to be placed on the 2026 Colorado ballot.

To that end, we have issued a letter to the Catholic faithful explaining the ballot initiatives and the need for Catholics who are registered to vote in Colorado to sign the petitions, and if able, volunteer to collect signatures. - October 4-5, the weekend of the Feast of St. Francis of Assisi, Patron Saint of Colorado
- November 1-2, the weekend of All Saints and All Souls Feast Days




