

astor's Blog What a Week!



Every once in a while, God sends us a special gift. This week was one of those gifts. Our feasts this week come right out of the hall of fame of the Communion of Saints.

Monday, we celebrated the Archangels: Michael the warrior, Gabriel the messenger, and Raphael the healer. Then Thursday we followed that up with the celebration of the Guardian Angels – those special angelic protectors given to each one of us to help us get safely through life and into heaven.

Tuesday, we remembered St. Jerome, Doctor of the Church. A master of Latin, Greek, and Hebrew, he spent the last thirty years of his life living in a cave in Bethlehem translating the scriptures into Latin. His famous quote, "Ignorance of Scripture is ignorance of Christ" points us to one of the best ways to encounter Our Lord. Pilgrims to the Holy Land can celebrate mass in St. Jerome's cave.

Wednesday, we celebrated another Doctor of the Church – St. Thérèse of the Child Jesus. Known as the Little Flower, her biography, The Story of a Soul, taught us the "little way" of loving Jesus.

The week climaxed on Saturday with the celebration of St. Francis of Assisi, son of a merchant turned soldier, turned saint. He teaches us the way of poverty and love for the poor.

Weeks like this remind us how great it is to be Catholic and to be members of God's family surrounded by such a great cloud of witnesses.

Office during regular business hours. Your generosity is greatly appreciated!





Signature Collection Drives at St. Jude Parish

The Colorado Catholic Conference of bishops support and encourage signature collection for Colorado initiatives #108 Penalties for Human Trafficking of a Minor, #109 Male and Female Participation in School Sports, and #110 Prohibit Certain Surgeries on Minors. These initiatives each require nearly 125,000 valid signatures within six months of their kick-off in early September to be placed on the 2026 Colorado ballot.

To that end, we have issued a letter to the Catholic faithful explaining the ballot initiatives and the need for Catholics who are registered to vote in Colorado to sign the petitions, and if able, volunteer to collect signatures. Protect Kids Colorado is a partner of the Colorado Catholic Conference and the sponsor of all three parental rights initiatives. They are organizing the effort to collect signatures across the state. We will be collecting signatures at St. Jude on the following weekends:

- October 4-5, the weekend of the Feast of St. Francis of Assisi, Patron Saint of Colorado
- November 1-2, the weekend of All Saints and All Souls Feast Days
