Pastor's Blog

Two by Two



In St. Peter's Basilica in Rome, lie the bones of Saints Simon and Jude. They rest together in the same tomb. Their feasts are celebrated together every year on October 28th. Of course, St. Jude is our patron saint, and we will be celebrating his feast this weekend with a nice dinner.

Although they are listed in the Gospels as among the twelve Apostles, little is known of their lives. St. Jude is called Jude Thaddeus (not to be confused with Judas Iscariot who betrayed Jesus). Simon is called Simon the Zealot (not to be confused with Simon Peter, the first Pope). Tradition holds that they traveled together to Persia to preach the Gospel and were martyred there together in the year 65.

St. Jude is the patron saint of hopeless and desperate causes. It's not clear how this title came about, but tradition states that, because he shared a name with Judas Iscariot, Saint Jude's intercession was rarely sought. However, after the intercession of every other Apostle was tried, people in the early Church would turn to Saint Jude as their last hope. The intercession of Saint Jude has provided many miracles throughout the centuries.

Sharing a feast day with another saint is a great model for us of holy friendship. God puts fellow travelers in our lives to love us, encourage us, hold us accountable, and help us grow in holiness.

Saints Simon and Jude - together in life, together in death, together in heaven!

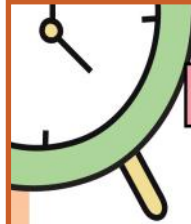

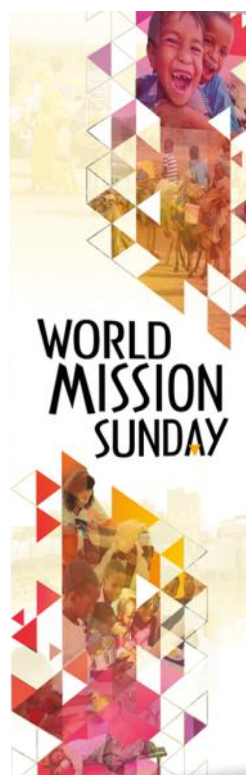

Today we recognize World Mission Sunday! Every parish across the globe joins together for the only worldwide collection mandated by Canon Law—World Mission Sunday. Your generosity today supports the Pope's missions in more than 1,124 territories where the Church is young or struggling.

This year's theme—"Missionaries of Hope Among the Peoples"—is a call to embody the love of God, poured into our hearts by the Holy Spirit (cf. Rom 5:5). Your offering today provides hope where despair too often dominates—through the building of churches, formation of seminarians and religious sisters, healthcare clinics, and Catholic schools.

Signature Collection Drives at St. Jude Parish

The Colorado Catholic Conference of bishops support and encourage signature collection for Colorado initiatives #108 Penalties for Human Trafficking of a Minor, #109 Male and Female Participation in School Sports, and #110 Prohibit Certain Surgeries on Minors. These initiatives each require nearly 125,000 valid signatures within six months of their kick-off in early September to be placed on the 2026 Colorado ballot.

To that end, we have issued a letter to the Catholic faithful explaining the ballot initiatives and the need for Catholics who are registered to vote in Colorado to sign the petitions, and if able, volunteer to collect signatures. 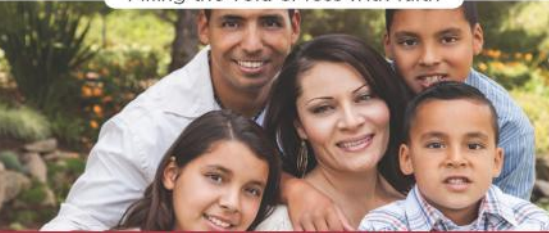
