

More Here Than Meets the Eye

H2O exists in three states: Solid, liquid and gas (ice, water and steam). The Church also exists in three states: Suffering, Militant and Triumphant (The Souls in Purgatory, The Church on earth, and the Angels and Saints in Heaven.)

This weekend, we contemplate this mystery as we celebrate All Saints Day and All Souls Day. While we celebrate the feasts of individual saints throughout the year, on all Saints Day we celebrate them as a group. These souls – both known and unknown – look upon the face of God. On All Souls Day we remember the souls in Purgatory. These souls died in friendship with God but were imperfectly purified on earth and so, by God's mercy, continue their purification after death until they can enter heaven. We here on earth comprise the Church Militant – soldiers of Christ engaged in the great cosmic battle for souls.

The Communion of Saints is the entire family of God in all three states, helping each other. We help the souls in Purgatory with our prayers and good works. The Saints in heaven pray for us and encourage us — much like the crowd in the stadium cheers the players on the field. At every Mass, the entire Communion of Saints is present! The saints and angels join us in adoring Christ present on the altar. The poor souls gather in hopeful expectation, waiting for their suffering to end. What mystery! There's more here than meets the eye.

Signature Collection Drives at St. Jude Parish

The Colorado Catholic Conference of bishops support and encourage signature collection for Colorado initiatives #108 Penalties for Human Trafficking of a Minor, #109 Male and Female Participation in School Sports, and #110 Prohibit Certain Surgeries on Minors. These initiatives each require nearly 125,000 valid signatures within six months of their kick-off in early September to be placed on the 2026 Colorado ballot.

To that end, we have issued a letter to the Catholic faithful explaining the ballot initiatives and the need for Catholics who are registered to vote in Colorado to sign the petitions, and if able, volunteer to collect signatures. 
