



Going to Mom's House



The first Christians gathered secretly for worship in the catacombs and in private homes. Pilgrims to Rome can still visit these sites today. As persecution eased, they were able to gather publicly. The Apostles and their successors became the first bishops of the church. The successor of St. Peter would be the bishop of Rome. Saint John Lateran, built in 324 A.D., is the first Christian Basilica built explicitly to gather the entire city around its bishop.

Jesus established the Kingdom of Heaven on earth - a universal covenant. That word universal comes from the Greek word for Catholic. We are members of a worldwide family. Our local church home is Saint Jude. Our local mother church is the Cathedral Basilica of the Immaculate Conception in downtown Denver. There we gather around our Bishop for worship. Our universal mother church is The Lateran Basilica - the Pope's cathedral. Its title is *Mater et Caput Omnium Ecclesiarum* – Mother and Head of All Churches.

Like every family, we gather at mom's house for special occasions. We should all try to attend a mass at the Denver Cathedral. Most of us will never visit the Lateran Basilica. So today, we join in spirit with Catholics all over the world to celebrate our mother church.




