
# SAINT JUDE CATHOLIC CHURCH

St. Jude will celebrate this Holy Day of Obligation with Mass on Monday, **December 8th** at 8 am and 6:30 pm.




Please note: Adoration will end early at 6 pm in order to prepare for evening Mass. There will not be a vigil Mass the night before.



# astor's Blog

### **Christ the King**





Advent. Today was the last Sunday that we read from Cycle "C" and next Sunday we will begin reading from Cycle "A". As we conclude the annual liturgical cycle, I want to unpack the meaning of acknowledging Jesus as "Christ the King."

In 1925 Pope Pius XI felt that an observance was necessary to consider the supremacy of Jesus. The growing secularism and nationalism of the 1920's prompted his declaration. The Feast of Christ the King was celebrated throughout the Catholic world immediately after its inception, but in a particular way the Mexican confessors championed the promotion. The persecution against Catholics in Mexico began at almost the same time that the Christ the King annual celebration was inaugurated. (For a good movie on the plight of the Cristeros in Mexico, consider watching "For Greater Glory.") As a result, many of those who were faithful to Christ in the persecution used the slogan, "Long live Christ the King!" ("¡Que vive Cristo Rey!") Remember Saint Miguel Pro's beautiful cry of proclaiming Christ the King as he was shot for his faith in Mexico. His martyrdom was recorded by the media who were invited by the Mexican Federal Government to witness his execution. Such a holy proclamation of faith should inspire us to likewise proclaim with our lives that Jesus Christ is the King even when the secularists want to silence us!

We meet September through May in the St Benedict room every Wednesday, from 9:00 am -11:00 am. Our next meeting is





**Marriage:** Those who wish to be married at St. Jude Church must be registered in the parish for at least one


**Funeral Arrangements:** Call the office 303-988-6435 and ask for Sharon Hensley.




