

#### **A Cowboy Christmas Message**

Saint Jude Parish has adopted a bit of a cowboy theme for the proclamation of Christmas this year. The cowboy theme was inspired by the recent visit of Father Bryce Lungren, who is the author of the book you received. He offered three pieces of cowboy advice which correspond to the spiritual life. The cowboy advice is: always wear your hat; leave a little nail; and back up only as much as necessary.

Cowboys will always wear their hats not only for the material assistance on the open range but also because it identifies them as a cowboy. In the spiritual life, we should easily be identified as a Christian. The life of sacraments and virtue, which sets us apart from the pagans, should be easy to see in our actions. Secondly, when cowboys trim their fingernails, they leave some of the nail as it will help them to do their work. In the spiritual life, we should always be ready to work and to make the sacrifices which the Lord Jesus asks of us. If we have become so groomed and comfortable that we cannot offer sacrificial service to Christ, we have "trimmed too much of the nail." Finally, a cowboy will only back up his horse as much as necessary before turning and going forward. In the spiritual life, we back up by repenting of our sins in the Sacrament of Confession. Once we have confessed our sins and received absolution, we do not look back on our sins. We go forward with confidence in our spiritual walk with Jesus Christ.




